CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT

- ◆ **Fees are payable one week prior to class commencement, if no deposit or fee has been received we cannot hold your place.**
- ◆ Refunds will NOT be given once the class has commenced as we are committed to course costs i.e. Tutor's fees, administration, advertising etc. Refunds will only be given if the class is cancelled.
- ◆ Fees may be paid in instalments if **PRIOR ARRANGEMENT IS MADE**. However 25% deposit of total course fee will be required. Students are still responsible for the **ENTIRE COURSE FEE** whether or not they attend each session.
